



Agility Training Registration and Insurance Waiver form for the 2018 Calendar Year

This Registration Form and Insurance Waiver covers Agility Training Classes offered by Paws4Fun Agility in which you, the undersigned, and the named dog participate in the cited Calendar Year.

Each session of classes is 8 hours in length and each class is a minimum of 1 hour per week in duration for a total of 8 hours of classes per session. Outdoor classes are run rain or shine. Cancellation of a class is at the Instructor's discretion and the Instructor will re-schedule a make-up class. Students will be asked to help in moving equipment to set-up the class and to clear the area after the class, as necessary.

Class fees for each 8 hour training session are as listed on our website on the training page, in the PayPal Payment drop down list. Fees differ by training level, indoor or outdoor. Club members benefit from a discounted rate.

Registration for training:

Be sure to confirm your session, membership and registration procedure with the Training Director at training@paws4funagility.ca before making a payment. Completion and submission of the year's registration and insurance waiver form is a pre-requisite for admission to training in each calendar year and may be for each training session in the year.

Rules of Conduct for Training:

1. Your dog is your responsibility and you are responsible for all of your dog's actions.
2. You MUST ensure that your dog is under control at all times. Different sizes of dogs with different prey-drives will be on the property at the same time. Ensure that you have control of your dog to prevent any altercations.
3. Your dog must be on leash unless running in the ring. Even though on leash, please ask before allowing your dog to 'visit' another dog. Both for safety's sake, and because it is important for the dogs to learn to wait for permission, so they can maintain focus in the ring.
4. Do not tie your dog to the t-bars or fences on the club's property. Do not slip your leash over the t-bar while it is attached to your dog. If you must leave your dog use either a crate or tie-out or ask someone to hold your dog for you. (Note: even though someone may agree to hold your dog, you are still responsible for its actions. You know your dog best and should act accordingly.)
5. Dogs are normally run in the ring in a flat collar during classes for safety reasons. If you have any doubt on the suitability of your collar, consult with your instructor.
6. Pick up after your dog. Garbage cans are available for the disposal of poop bags.
7. Do not allow your dog to foul the ring. If your dog has an accident in the ring, pick up any solids & flush the area with water as a courtesy to other users.
8. Do not throw food into tunnels. This can remain in situ and be a serious distraction to other dogs as well as attracting wildlife.
9. Remember that the instructors are volunteering their time to teach and we are fortunate to have them. They are the club's representative during the class.
10. Students may be asked to help with set up/teardown of courses for their class.
11. Classes will be held rain or shine unless cancelled by the instructor for safety reasons (ex lightning or very strong winds). In this case instructors will arrange for make-up classes.

12. Classes have priority access to their assigned rings during their assigned times and for ½ hour before class for any set-up work required. When not assigned to a class, rings are available to club members for practice.
