



# K9 KUP RULES & LEVELS

<b>Untitled:</b>	Dog (or junior handler) does not hold any AAC titles.
<b>More than 3 years at K9Kup:</b>	Dog (or junior handler) that has previously been at competitor in K9 Kup for 3 seasons or more will be scored as if they have the equivalent to an ADC.
<b>AAC Title:</b>	Only one dog (or junior handler) will be counted in the top four scores used to calculate team standings.
<b>Regular Class:</b>	Suitable for inexperienced dogs and handlers. Standard Course Time (SCT) is that of AAC Starters level. Dogs compete at normal jump heights as specified by AAC rules. <b>If you want your dog to jump one or two jump heights lower select "Special Class"</b>
<b>Special Class:</b>	Dogs competing one or two jump heights lower than their normal height. The spread, broad and double jumps are not included and the A-Frame will be set at 5' only. Wall jumps will be used if present. Standard Course Time "SCT" will be the same as the Regular Class.
<b>Veteran Class:</b>	Dogs 5 years or older competing one or two jump heights lower than their normal height. The spread, broad and double jumps are not included and the A-Frame will be set at 5' only. Wall jumps will be used if present. Standard Course time "SCT" will be greater than the Regular Class.
<b>Challenged Class:</b>	Dog or handler has a physical challenge that will not allow them to compete in the other classes. Specifics of the challenge must be relayed to the organizer at <a href="mailto:k9kup@paws4funagility.ca">k9kup@paws4funagility.ca</a> Although they may be attached to a team, these participants will not be scored on a team but will compete individually. Challenged participants compete entirely at their own risk.
<b>Running on Leash</b>	Is not permitted.
<b>Entry Restrictions:</b>	K9 Kup will be restricted to 15 teams of a maximum of 10 dogs per team. P4FA must receive full payment and registration forms from <b>a minimum of 6 team members</b> for the team to be registered. <b>Full payment for all members must be received by 1 May or the team status may be rescinded.</b> A notice will be posted on the P4FA website once the maximum number of teams has been reached. Applications received after that time may be placed on teams with empty spots if any and the applicant(s) notified.

- Notes:**
- 1. Dogs with 2 or more Advanced Standard Qs at time of registration are no longer able to compete in the K9Kup unless run by a Junior Handler.**
  - 2. Dogs obtaining any Titles must notify organizer of title.**
  - 3. Recommended minimum age for dogs is 12 months. A handler may enter a younger dog at their own risk. It is strongly recommend that they use a lower jump height.**

  - 5. Bitches in season are prohibited.**
