Staying up to date on requirements, keeping everyone informed

- a) Every Monday, the Webmaster will check Ontario.ca and the Leeds, Grenville and Lanark Health Unit website for any updates to Provincial Orders.
- b) The President will send email to all Club Members whenever Provincial Order changes impact the Club operations.
- c) The Webmaster will maintain a current understanding of all relevant COVID-19 regulations and local by-law requirements.
- d) All Board Members and Coordinators will flag any relevant information they see in the news and post it in the Paws4Fun Board and Coordinators Facebook Chat Group or send it to the Board and Coordinators via email.
- e) The Webmaster will ensure that this plan is posted on the Paws4Fun Agility Club website and email Board Members and Coordinators whenever there is a change.
- f) The Membership Coordinator is responsible for making sure that the Board and Coordinator email and phone contact information is kept up to date. All are responsible for informing the Membership Coordinator if their information changes.
- g) The President will ensure that any notices required by Leeds, Grenville and Lanark Health Unit or other government regulations are printed and posted visibly.
