General Information - (Limited Entry Trial)

This is not an Agility Association of Canada (AAC) sanctioned trial but will be generally held under AAC rules and regulations. Note that the Paws4Fun Agility Trials Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. **The judge may dismiss from the ring at any time any dog she feel is unsafe for competition.** There shall be no refunds for acts of God, inclement weather, missed runs, entries withdrawn after the closing date, if a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event the dog is absent on the day of the trial. However, refunds will be given to a competitor whose bitch comes into season or whose dog is injured, provided that the trial secretary (TrialsSecretary@Paws4FunAgility.ca) is informed prior to the trial date and a certificate from a veterinarian is provided at that time, if required. It is the Paws4Fun Agility policy to provide, on a case-by-case basis, either refund of monies or credits to be used at a future trial based on a decision by the Board of Directors, however, an administrative fee may be retained on all refunded entries. A service fee of \$25 will be charged on all NSF cheques.

Title Trial:All dogs are considered vets for the purpose of this event. The courses are built with no spreads or doubles and extra time to account for our RAD's.. No more than one contact will be used per course and it will be set at lower than special vet height for safety of our RAD's. Tunnelers course is a course with only tunnels. .

Obstacles: All obstacles conform to AAC specifications. Obstacles may include A-frame, Dog Walk, See-Saw, Weave Poles, Table, Flexible Tunnels,, Self-healing Tire Jump, and Single Bar Jumps. Note, some one piece metal jumps may be included. All contacts are rubberized. An electronic timing system will be used.

Facilities: The trial will be held outdoors on the Paws4Fun Agility grass fields and will proceed rain or shine. Portable washrooms are available. Bring your own seating, drinking water and dog crates. There is plenty of space for setting up shade tents, which are recommended as shade is limited. There will be access to a pool with non-potable water to cool the dogs. For those who wish to crate their dogs in their cars, limited parking space is available inside the fenced perimeter. **Note that the perimeter gate will be locked to vehicular ingress and egress when events are being run Ring #1.**

Dog Aggression: All dogs must be kept in an X-pen, crate, in your car, or on leash when not in the ring (this includes the grounds and parking lot). No retractable leashes are allowed on Paws4Fun property. In order to avoid incidents of dog aggression towards other dogs and/or people, please give all dogs lots of room and be aware of your dog's behavior at all times. Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave the grounds. In such cases, NO refunds will be issued.

Ring Etiquette: If you are not entered in a specific event, you are NOT permitted in the ring during the walk-through. If you are entered in an event and you are coaching others (or being coached by others), please show consideration for the rest of the competitors by doing your coaching OUTSIDE the ring and do not block other competitors, or hold strategy discussions in the ring during the walk through. Thank you for showing respect for all competitors.

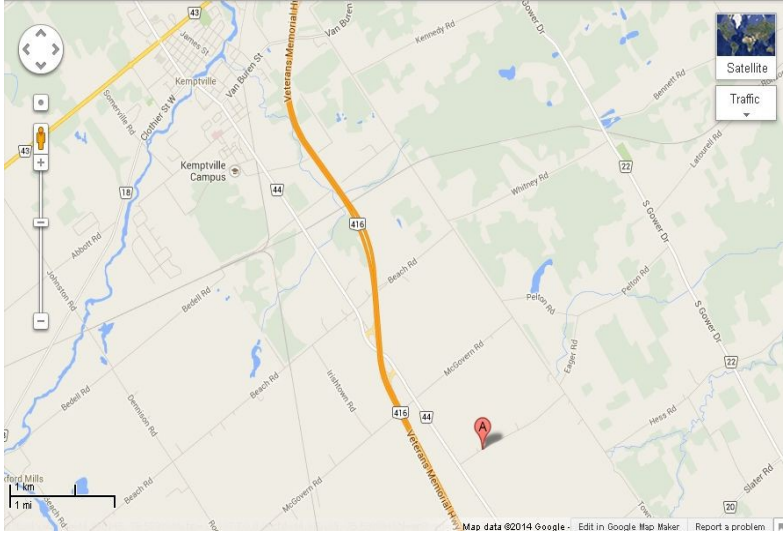
